TITLE OF BILL : An act to amend the family court act and the criminal procedure law, in relation to orders of protection and the definition of "members of the same family or household"

PURPOSE OF BILL : This bill is intended to provide protections to the close to 50% of domestic violence victims who are currently not covered by the strengthened protections of the 1994 Family Protection and Domestic Violence Intervention Act. The bill updates the jurisdiction provisions of the family court act and criminal procedure law to include unrelated persons who live or have lived in the same household. Such persons have been eligible for state funded domestic violence services since 1987, but currently cannot obtain an order of protection in family court or under criminal procedure law section 530.11. The bill also gives these increased protections to unrelated persons who are or have been in intimate or dating relationships. In so doing, New York joins the 35 other states which protect such persons.
